KOEHLER MEMORIAL WASHINGTON STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

June 17-18, 2023 (NRA Registered) September 23-24, 2023 (NRA Reg'd, WSRPA Sanctioned)

RANGE LOCATION: See map on the back of this program. The TR&R range has 27 paved and covered firing points. Facilities include rest rooms, picnic area and overnight parking with limited electric hookups for RVs (no water or sewer hookups). There are no lunch facilities, but fast-food places are nearby on Bridgeport Way. Shooters will be required to sign a TR&RC liability waiver form, unless one is on file. *Upon arrival at the gate, push the <u>big black button</u> and the gate will open for you. Ditto when exiting.*

RULES: Both matches are registered. Current NRA smallbore rifle rules and official NRA targets will be used. Competitors will hang targets. **BRING TARGET CLIPS!** <u>EYE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED</u>

ELIGIBILITY: Open to NRA members and non-members alike. Resident entrants to the Washington State Championship must be members of the Washington State Rifle & Pistol Association. WSRPA applications will be available in the Stat Office.

CLASSIFICATION: Competitors must use their current NRA conventional prone classification. Temporary and assigned classifications may also be used. All other unclassified competitors will fire in the Master Class.

SQUADDING & PRACTICE: Squadding assignments will be made at the Statistical Office on Saturday morning. The range will be open for limited practice on Friday afternoon before the tournament.

SCORING & CHALLENGES: Targets will be scored in the Statistical Office. The challenge fee is \$2.00. Challenges not resolved in the Statistical Office will be decided by Jury. The Statistical Office is closed to all competitors except when a score is being challenged. Targets will be scored using the new Orion scoring apt.

ENTRY: *ADVANCE ENTRY IS REQUESTED*, Contact Jim Greeves, e-mail, <u>jjjjgr@comcast.net</u>. When entering via email, <u>please include your NRA conventional prone</u> <u>classification, your category, and advise if left-handed</u>. Also indicate <u>what days you plan to shot</u>. Entry in both matches is limited to 54 competitors, with preference given to package entry.

AGGREGATES

TROPHIES: Vern Koehler Memorial perpetual trophy. **Washington State Championship** - Perpetual trophies for winner of each match and each class winner in the grand aggregate including High Senior. All perpetual trophies must be returned for next year's competition.

AWARDS: NRA Award Points, cash or trophies / medals will be awarded in accordance with the award schedule. TR&R medals are available for those not wanting to receive Award Points or cash. Category awards will be given to High Senior and High Junior in the Grand Aggregate, provided there are at least three entries per category.
