DATE: 7 October, 2018.

LOCATION: Cascade Shooting Facilities outdoor range at the King County Shooting Sports Park.
26520 292nd Ave S.E., Ravensdale, Washington.

RULES: Current NRA rules will govern.

ARMS: Service Rifle (rule 3.1(c)). Other rifles will be allowed, but will not be eligible for awards.

CATEGORIES: M16 (AR15) Service Rifle.

OPEN TO: All High-Power competitors. The public is welcome to participate.

ENTRY: This match is limited to 45 competitors. Match fee is \$15.50, NRA Registration fee is \$4.50, with a total entry fee of \$20.00. Junior shooters, Match fee is \$5.50, NRA Reg. fee is \$4.50, with a total entry fee of \$10.00.

TIME: Registration 0800-0900 Firing begins at 0915.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master class.

TARGETS: 200 yd SR, 300 yd SR-3, 600 yd MR-1. SR-42 may be used in inclement weather

AWARDS: Cash awards, rule of 4. Classes may be combined. Match Winner, High Junior, High Woman.

PULLING TARGETS: Competitors will pull targets or provide their own puller. Competitors will be held responsible for contracted pullers.

MATCH COURSE

2 sighters + 20 shots for record Standing, 200 yd.	Time: 22 minutes
2 sighters, 200 yd.	Time: 2 minutes
2 strings of 10 shots for record Rapid Fire Sitting, 200 yd.	Time: 60 seconds/string
2 sighters, 300 yd.	Time: 2 minutes
2 strings of 10 shots for record Rapid Fire Prone, 300 yd.	Time: 70 seconds/string
2 sighters + 20 shots for record Prone, 500 yd.	Time: 22 minutes
