

# 2019 NRA OPEN INTERNATIONAL AIR PISTOL, FREE PISTOL AND STANDARD PISTOL SECTIONAL MATCHES

March 9 & 10, 2019

- Location:** The Roger Dahl Rifle Training Range, which is located under the West Seattle Stadium and adjacent to the West Seattle Golf Course at 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW and Snoqualmie Street in Seattle, Washington. The address is 4470 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW.
- Rules:** The current NRA International Pistol Rules will govern.

- Score Cards:** A special score card will be used.
- Distance:** Free and Standard Pistol Fifty feet  
Air Pistol 10 Meters
- Pistol:** Standard Rule 3.5  
Free Rule 3.6  
Air Pistol Rule 3.7
- Targets:** NRA Official 50 foot and 10 meter targets.  
Standard Pistol B-33  
Free Pistol B-11  
Air Pistol B-40/1
- Eligibility:** A competitor (individual or team) may enter no more than one International Open Air, Free Pistol and Standard Pistol Sectional in 2019
- Teams:** A team will consist of (3) firing members representing a club or group that has determined by rules 2.11(A),(B), state association 2.12, or 2.13 Teams composed of competitors not in the same category are mixed teams. Mixed teams in Sectionals may fire for open awards only. All teams members must be named and entered before any member of the team may begin individual firing.
- Classification:** Each competitor will be classified according to the NRA International

Classification system. A classification card or score record book should be available. Unclassified competitors will be classified per rule 19.6. Teams will be classified per rule 19.12.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged as per rule 16.1.

Ties : Ties will broken according to rule 15.

Fees: Fees for Match 1, Air Pistol are \$15.00 per individual and \$15.00 per team.

Fees for Match 2, Standard Pistol are \$15.00 per individual and \$15.00 per team.

Fees for Match 1, Free Pistol are \$15.00 per individual and \$15.00 per team.

Squading:

**Air Pistol: 03/09/2018** Squading will be on a first come, first served basis. Firing will start at 8:30 AM using infiltration. Last assigned shooter will start at or before 10:30 AM. If match has a large turn out time will be extended.

**Standard Pistol: 03/09/2019 and 03/10/2019** Squading will be on a first come, first served basis. Saturday firing to begin at or about 12:00 PM or when last air pistol is finished. Sunday firing will begin after Free Pistol match at or about 12:00 PM If required additional relays will added.

**Free Pistol: 03/10/2018** Squading will be on a first come, first served basis. Relays will start at 8:30 AM and 10:30 AM

Reservations may be made and are recommended to reduce waiting time.

Course of Fire:

**Air Pistol:** 60 shots will be fired for record. Five shots each target. Total time 1 hour 45 min.

**Standard Pistol:** Slow Fire Stage 20 shots in 4 series of 5 shots each. Time 150 seconds per 5 shot series.

Timed fire stage 20 shots in 4 series of 5 shots each. Time 20 seconds per 5 shot series.

Rapid Fire stage 20 shots in 4 series of 5 shots each. Time 10 seconds per 5 shot series.

Five sighting shots may be shot prior to the match. Time limit is 150 seconds. A separate target will be used.

**Free Pistol:** 60 shots will be fired for record. The match will be fired on six targets of 10 shots each. Total time for the 60 shots is 2 hours.

All team matches are non-fired match. Scores from the individual match are used.

Awards: Match winners NRA medallion and Award points. Class awards are NRA Award points. Juniors who have indicated on their entry card that they do not wish to receive award points, will be given other awards..
