MATCH DATES: Friday, Saturday & Sunday, June 26-28, 2020

REGISTRATION: Friday - 1:30-2:00 PM MDT at the pits. Clinic starts at ~2:00PM
Saturday - 7:45-8:15AM MDT at the pits. Firing starts at ~8:30AM.
Sunday - 7:00-7:20AM MDT at the pits. Firing starts at ~7:30AM

LOCATION: The Deep Creek Rifle Range Complex west of Missoula, MT off Mullan Rd. Exit I-90 at exit 101. Proceed south on Reserve St. 1.5 miles to the intersection of Mullan and Reserve. Turn right (west) on Mullan; proceed 5 miles to Kona Ranch Rd. Look for the large brown signs to the range beginning at this point. Turn left (south) on Kona Ranch and follow the signs for the next 7.5 miles. Note – the pavement ends on Kona Ranch about 2 miles from Mullan. The remainder is graded logging road. Drive up the Deep Creek Draw, along Deep Creek. The range is on the right side at the top of hill. Look for a trailer, sheds and vehicles. The Public range is to the left and High Power range is to the right – past the trailer and through the green gate. Once past the green gate proceed along the perimeter road to the target shed in the vicinity of the target pits. Google Maps link: <http://g.co/maps/vu3xk>

RULES: CMP High Power Rifle rules will govern. **Hearing and eye protection are required on the firing line and in the pits.** See rules on-line: [CMP Rule Book](#)

ELIGIBILITY: Open to men and women who support the rights of citizens to keep and bear arms. MRPA members will receive a \$5 match entry fee discount. NRA and MRPA membership applications will be available at registration. New shooters are welcome and encouraged to attend!

CATEGORIES: Service (Includes Active, Reserve & Nat'l Guard), Civilian

MATCH FEES: Team Match: \$5 per shooter – paid at the range by team captain. Individual matches: See entry form on last page. Late fee may apply. Match fees include CMP registration fees, awards paid back at ~60%, catered *Famous Dave's* dinner and the remainder goes to expenses and Hellgate Civilian Shooters Association. Extra dinners may be purchased for \$11.

ENTRIES: Team Match (CMP rule 2.7): Limited to 14 two-person teams. Teams may be “pick-up” teams arranged on the day of the match. Team entries will be by advance entry or during team registration on the day of the team match. Individual Matches: Individual entries will be limited to 42 shooters – three relays maximum. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

ADVANCE ENTRY IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED! Competitors guarantee an individual entry in the matches by sending payment with registration form; **entries will be on a first come, first served basis up to range capacity.** Late entries made on match day will be accepted up to limit of range capacity. Preference will be given to competitors shooting all days.

CLASSIFICATION: The CMP Classification system will be used, CMP rule 5.11.4. Those without a CMP classification will utilize their NRA classification until they receive a CMP classification.

RIFLE DIVISIONS: CMP U.S. SERVICE RIFLE (CMP rule 4.1.1-4.1.2) and CMP MATCH RIFLE (CMP rule 4.1.5). Match Rifles are permitted and welcome, but not eligible to win the Service Rifle Championship, EIC match or receive Distinguished Rifleman points.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Competitors will also score (and be responsible for pit duty – if needed). Infiltration squadding may be utilized, if deemed necessary by the match director.

TARGETS: SR, SR-3, MR-1, Electronic targets – Shotmarker brand- will be utilized. Bring your Wi-Fi enabled device or smart phone.

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): ECI's are required and will be available for \$2.

CHALLENGES: As per the CMP Rule 6.6.

TRAINING MATCH

Friday, June 26, 2020, 2:00PM

This is a non-sanctioned training match; Course of Fire is subject to change based upon needs of participants. It may all take place at one yardage or maybe in the form of a clinic only. Times for the strings of fire will be flexible. Individuals wishing to utilize the time for individual practice are also welcome.

FIREARM DIVISIONS: Any CMP or NRA Match or Service Rifle for this non-sanctioned match.

TARGETS: SR-1, SR,SR-3, MR63 (600yd target reduced to 300yds), MR-1

Course of Fire (potential)

Stage 1 – Standing slow-fire, 2 sighting shots & 10 shots for record, time 10 min, 200yds.

Stage 2 – Sitting or kneeling, 2 sighting shots & 10 shots for record, time 60 sec, 200yds.

Stage 3 – Prone, rapid-fire, rapid-fire, 2 sighting shots & 10 shots for record, time 70 sec, 300yds.

Stage 4 – Prone, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots & 10 shots for record, time 20 min, 300yds.

Saturday, June 27, 2020, 8:30AM

CMP CUP MATCH - Long Course Aggregate Course of Fire

Match 1 – Standing, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 200yds
(Competitors will remain on the line to fire Match 2)

Match 2 – Sitting or kneeling, rapid-fire, 2 sighting shots and two 10 shot strings for record, time 60 sec per 10 shot string, 200 yds. Shooters may start in position

Match 3 – Prone, rapid-fire, 2 sighting shots and two 10 shot strings for record, time 70 sec per 10 shot string, 300 yds. Shooters may start in position

Match 4 – Prone, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 600 yds

Match 5 – Prone, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 600 yds

Sunday, June 28, 2020, 7:30AM

National Trophy Event Course of Fire

Match 6 – Presidents Rifle Course format team match: 2 person teams; teams *may* be formed by the Match Director onsite. There are NO SIGHTERS, no alibis and shooters start rapid fire in standing. Coaching is encouraged.

Stage 1: Prone, slow-fire, 600yds –10 shots for record per team member, 1st relay – pair firing in 20 min block time, then pit change. 2nd relay – pair fire in 20 minute block time (right shooter fires first.)

Stage 2: Prone, rapid-fire, 10 shot string, time 70 sec, 300yds

Stage 3: Standing, slow-fire, 200yds - 10 shots for record per team member, 1st relay – pair firing in 20 min block time, then pit change. 2nd relay – pair fire in 20 minute block time (right shooter fires first.)

Sunday, June 28, 2020, ~10:00AM

Course of Fire

Match 7 – CMP SERVICE RIFLE EIC, 50 SHOT NATIONAL MATCH COURSE OF FIRE. There are NO SIGHTERS, no alibis and shooters start rapid fire in standing:

Stage 1 - Standing, slow-fire, 10 shots for record, time 10 min, 200 yds.

(Competitors will remain on the line to fire Stage 2)

Stage 2 - Sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid-fire, 10 shot string, time 60 sec, 200yds

Stage 3 - Prone from standing, rapid-fire, 10 shot string, time 70 sec, 300yds

Stage 4 - Prone, slow-fire, 20 shots for record, time 20 min, 600 yds

Match 8 Grand Aggregate: Montana State Service Rifle Champion-Aggregate of all **individual** matches.

AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to each match winner (except EIC match) and to the high individuals in each class/award group for each match in accordance with a schedule below. Team awards will be nominal. EIC points towards the Distinguished Rifleman Badge will be awarded (see CMP rule 10.2.6). All EIC medals and points toward the Distinguished Rifleman award will be issued by the CMP. Award groups must contain a minimum of 3 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group, per policy. Masters will not be combined with the High Master class. If fewer than 3 High Masters are entered they will compete for match winner awards only. Montana State Service Rifle Champion will be a Montana resident with the highest score in Match 8. Overall match winner may be from another state.

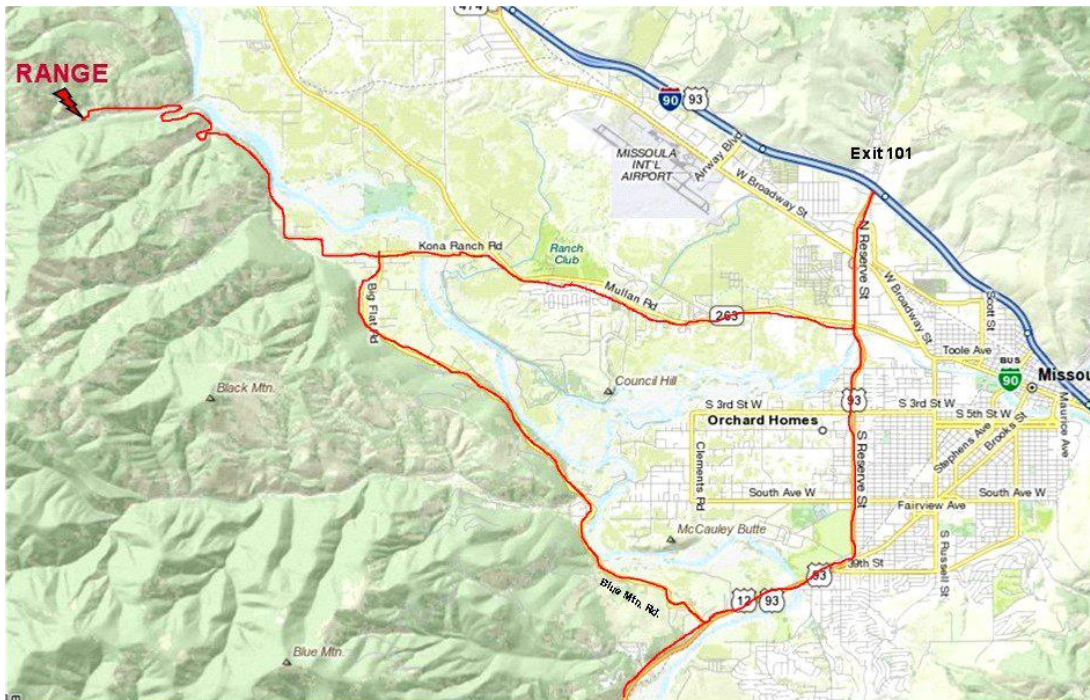

SPECIAL AWARD CATEGORIES: In Match 8, High shooters in: Service, Montana National Guard, Junior, Women, Senior, Match Rifle will be recognized - if there are at least 3 in a category.

GENERAL NOTES:

- CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement Required
- Competitors are required to furnish their own ammunition (CMP Rule 6.8). This tournament requires ~250 rounds for sighters and record. Plan accordingly for extra. Ammunition *may* be made available to a competitor, if previous arrangements are made.
- The protest period will be 30 minutes after the day's results are posted. Match results will be compiled immediately after the match and available for review in the campground.
- These matches are subject to rescheduling or cancellation due to imminent threat of forest fire or heavy smoke from nearby fires. The course of fire is subject to change by the jury, if conditions warrant.
- Only individuals who register early will be sent email updates in the event of match rescheduling or cancellation.
- Saturday evening is the catered BBQ social and shooters must be present to be eligible for any prizes. In the past prizes have included reloading components, barrels, ammunition and magazines. While prizes are not guaranteed, we hope to acquire more prizes.
- No lunch service is available at the range, so plan accordingly. Camping at the range is terrific and permitted while attending this event, however, water and sanitary facilities are limited. For a list of motels do a *Google* search for Missoula area motels and select one on Reserve Street as it will offer easier access to the range (Reserve St. and I-90 is ~30 mins to the target pits).
