

2020 MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND IRONMAN TOURNAMENT XTC, MID RANGE & LONG RANGE MATCHES



NRA Registered Matches Sponsored by Hellgate Civilian Shooters Association – Missoula, Montana

MATCH DATES: Saturday, Sunday & Monday, May 23-25, 2020

REGISTRATION: Saturday - 8:00-8:30AM MDT at the target pits. Firing starts ~8:40AM.
Sunday - 8:00-8:30AM MDT at the target pits. Firing starts ~8:45AM
Memorial Day - 8:00-8:30AM MDT at the 1000yd line. Firing starts ~8:45AM

LOCATION: The Deep Creek Rifle Range Complex west of Missoula, MT off Mullan Rd. Exit I-90 at exit 101. Proceed south on Reserve St. 1.5 miles to the intersection of Mullan and Reserve. Turn right (west) on Mullan; proceed 5 miles to Kona Ranch Rd. Look for the large brown signs to the range beginning at this point. Turn left (south) on Kona Ranch and follow the signs for the next 7.5 miles. Note – the pavement ends on Kona Ranch about 2 miles from Mullan. The remainder is a (poorly) graded logging road – use caution. Drive up the Deep Creek Draw, along Deep Creek, which will be on your left as you head up the draw. The range is on the right side at the top of hill. Look for a trailer, sheds and vehicles. The Public range is to the left and High Power range is to the right – past the mobile home trailer and through the green gate. Once past the green gate proceed along the perimeter road to the target shed in the vicinity of the target pits (Saturday and Sunday). On Monday we will squad at the 1000yd line. RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle and F-Class rules will govern. See NRA high power and F-Class rules at: [NRA High Power Rule Book](#) **Hearing & eye protection required on the firing line and in the pits.**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all individuals who support the Second Amendment. NRA and MRPA membership are not required, but is encouraged. This is an NRA Registered tournament which allows for National Records to be set. **Only NRA members are eligible to set a National Record.** New shooters are welcome and encouraged to attend!

CATEGORIES: Service (Includes Active, Reserve & Nat'l Guard), Civilian, Police, Junior

MATCH FEES: See entry form on last page. Match fees include NRA fees, awards paid back at ~60%, catered dinner and the remainder goes to expenses and Hellgate Civilian Shooters Association. Extra dinners are \$12.

ENTRIES LIMITED TO: Team Matches: Limited to 14 four-person teams. Teams will consist of four firing members, and a captain or coach – if desired. Team coach or captain may be a firing member of the team. To be eligible to set a national record, a team must represent a club, a law enforcement agency, a regular service unit or a Reserve unit (includes National Guard). Teams may be “pick-up” teams arranged on the day of the match. See NRA HP rules 2.10-2.19. Team entries will be at the range just prior to the team matches. Individual Matches: Limited to 42 XTC, 42 Mid Range & 56 Long Range competitors.

ADVANCE ENTRY REQUIRED: Competitors guarantee an individual entry in the matches by sending payment with registration form to Jamey Williams; entries will be on a first come, first served basis up to range capacity. Competitors may cancel their early registration before May 12th and receive a refund, less a \$5.00 service fee. Cancellations after May 12th may result in forfeit of entry fees. Late entries made on May 23–25th will be accepted up to limit of range capacity. This match typically sells out; it is important to be registered early if you want to compete. Preference will be given to competitors shooting all days.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA Classification system will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 (Assigned Classification), or 19.2 (Temporary Classification) may be used.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Competitors will score and may be responsible for pit duty. Shotmarker Electronic targets are likely to be used. Infiltration squadding will be utilized.

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): ECI's are required and will be available.

CHALLENGES: \$2 fee, refunded if challenge is sustained. Present fee at time of challenge (rule 16.1)

CHALLENGE PERIOD: Ends 30 min. after results are posted.

NEW: Field Precision Rifle Course of Fire. In the separate match program is a course of fire for those wishing to use hunting rifles, military M24, M110, M2010 rifles and PRS style rifles. This is a further evolution of this unofficial rifle division we began a year ago. New this year is different positions at various yard lines using diverse equipment to challenge shooters in scenarios which might be encountered in competition, in tactical environments, or when hunting. You will be firing at electronic targets from 200yds out to 1000yds, and receive nearly instant *and* exact feedback on your shot placement. This will afford you an excellent opportunity to see the effects of wind drift and your POI offset with differing positions and equipment use. Our goal, as with traditional high power events, is to help shooters improve their marksmanship fundamentals to better prepare them for their chosen activity. This division, the course of fire and equipment allowed can and very likely will change based on shooter input. (See the Field Precision Rifle Program for the course of fire, which will run concurrent with the high power matches.)

XTC TARGETS: SR, SR-3, MR-1 & MRFC

XTC FIREARM DIVISIONS: Division A - Service Rifle (Rule 3.1), Division B - Match Rifle (rule 3.3). Division FPR - Field Precision Rifle.

Course of Fire

Match 1 – Standing, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 200yds
(Competitors will remain on the line to fire Match 2)

Match 2 – Sitting or kneeling, rapid-fire, 2 sighting shots and two 10 shot strings for record, time 60 sec per 10 shot string, 200 yds

Match 3 – Prone, rapid-fire, 2 sighting shots and two 10 shot strings for record, time 70 sec per 10 shot string, 300 yds

Match 4XTC – Prone, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 600 yds

Match 5XTC – Prone, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 600 yds

Match 6 – Aggregate of matches 1-5

MID RANGE - 600 YARD MATCHES

(These matches are run at the same time as the XTC match. Those not firing in the XTC match are welcome to shoot sling or F-Class. Squadding is LIMITED, must be prearranged and will take place behind the 300yd line during the XTC match at ~10:30.)

TARGETS: MR & MRFC

MID RANGE FIREARM DIVISIONS: Division A - Service Rifle, Division B – Any Rifle. Includes match rifle, Palma rifle, Any rifle/Any sight or AR Tactical rifle (bipod and AR platform rifle with optic - not eligible for overall win). Division F - F-Class Rifle (rule 22, 3.4 a & b). Division FPR - Field Precision Rifle.

Match 8 – Any-Sight, Prone, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 600 yds

Match 9 – Any-Sight, Prone, slow-fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time 22 min, 600 yds

Match 10 – Aggregate of matches 7-9

MID RANGE - TEAM MATCH

(Match will begin shortly after previous individual matches)

Match 11 – MID RANGE 4 PERSON TEAM MATCH: Any-Sight, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record at 600yds. 2 relays: 1st relay 47 min block time; *pit change*; 2nd relay - 47 min. block time at each yard line. Coaching encouraged.

LONG RANGE MATCHES

LONG RANGE FIREARM DIVISIONS: Division A - Service Rifle, Division B - Any Rifle - includes match rifle, Any Rifle/Any Sight (rule 3.2) or PALMA® Rifle (rule 3.3.1), or Division F - F-Class Rifle (rule 22, 3.4 a & b). Division FPR - Field Precision Rifle.

Course of Fire

Match 12 – Any-Sight, Prone, slow-fire, Unlimited sighting shots & 20 shots for record, time 30 min, 1000 yds

Match 13 – Any-Sight, Prone, slow-fire, Unlimited sighting shots & 20 shots for record, time 30 min, 1000 yds

Match 14 – Aggregate of matches 12 & 13

LONG RANGE - TEAM MATCH

Monday, May 25, 2020 ~12:00PM

(Match will begin shortly after previous individual matches)

Course of Fire

Match 15 – LONG RANGE 4 PERSON TEAM MATCH: Any-Sight, Unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record at 1000yds. 2 relays: 1st relay 63 min block time; *pit change*; 2nd relay - 63 min. block time at each yard line. Coaching encouraged.

Match 16: THE IRONMAN - Aggregate of all individual, fired matches.

MATCH AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to each Match Winner and to the high individuals in each Class/Division award group for each individual match in accordance with award schedule listed below. Award groups may be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy.

SPECIAL AWARD CATEGORIES: In Match #16, High Service Rifle, High Junior, High Senior awards will be given if more than 3 in the category. Match 16 awards will be based on an average classification for XTC/MR/LR as used in NRA team match classification averaging. These awards are independent of all other awards.

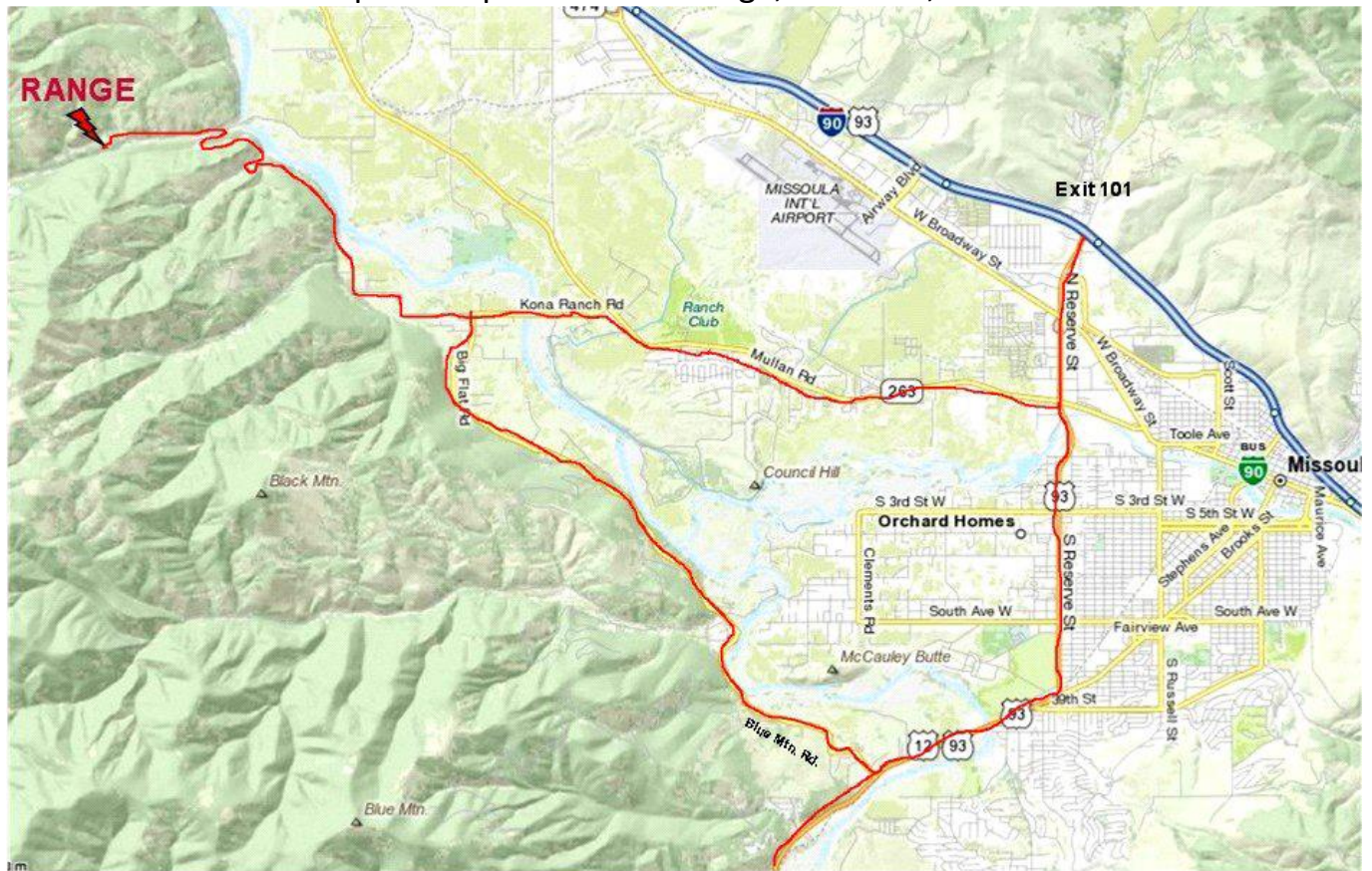
GENERAL NOTES:

- Coaching is permitted during team matches and during unlimited sighters.
- Service Rifle competitors must use any "Service Rifle" in every event to be eligible for "Service Rifle aggregate awards".
- This tournament requires ~110 XTC , 154 Mid range and 75 long range rounds for sighters and record in team and individual matches. Field Rifle shooters will need ~200 rounds. Plan accordingly and

bring extra. Ammunition *may* be made available to a competitor, if previous arrangements are made.

- If weather conditions warrant changing the course of fire, the jury will make that final decision, which could include changing the course to individual/team 2-3 x 1000yd for each day affected. Consider bringing enough LR ammo for this unlikely contingency (~75 rounds for the day, possibility of 3 days.)
- Preliminary match results will be compiled shortly after the match and available for review in the campground at the end of each day.
- First person on Sunday (at the pre-match safety brief) to tell me where the First Special Services Force trained wins a prize.
- Only individuals who register in advance will be sent email updates in the event of match rescheduling or cancellation.
- Match bulletins are emailed.
- Sunday evening is the catered BBQ social. Extra Dinners are \$12 and must be ordered one day in advance.
- No lunch service is available at the range, so plan accordingly. Camping at the range is terrific and permitted while attending this event, however, water and sanitary facilities are limited. For a list of motels do a *Google* search for Missoula area motels and select one on Reserve Street as it will offer easier access to the range (Reserve St. and I-90 is ~30 mins to the target pits).
- For the safety of the pit crew (or protection of the electronic targets), a competitor who fails to get on target in EIGHT SHOTS may be directed to stop firing.
